On March 19, 2020, the Governor of the State of California issue an order requiring all individuals living in California to stay home or in their place of residence except as needed to maintain continuity of operations of critical infrastructure sectors as outlined in <https://www.cisa.gov/critical-infrastructure-sectors>

Experior Laboratories has reviewed the order and determined that our testing operations and services fall within the definition of critical infrastructure sectors as outlined in the Governor's order, including the defense industrial base and communications sector. - Visitors must be prepared to answer screening questions and anyone presenting a risk will be denied access to our facility.
